

Multistate Outbreak of Salmonella Typhimurium Linked to Chicken Salad

Multiple cases of *Salmonella* Typhimurium have been identified after consuming chicken salad produced by Triple T Specialty Meats, Inc, and sold by Fareway stores in Illinois, Iowa, Minnesota, Nebraska, and South Dakota. In South Dakota, three cases of *Salmonella* have been reported with a history of chicken salad consumption from Fareway stores in southeast South Dakota. Additional laboratory testing is pending to confirm the three South Dakota cases with the 65 cases reported from 5 states (IL, IA, MN, NE, TX).

All chicken salad produced by Tripe T Specialty Meats has been recalled, and the South Dakota Department of Health recommends that consumers who purchased chicken salad from Fareway stores before February 9, 2018, throw it away in the trash.
