

Voluntary Halt on Sale of McDonald's Salad Mix

Public health authorities in Illinois and Iowa initially contacted McDonald's about concerns of *Cyclospora* infections. McDonald's announced on July 13, 2018, they would voluntarily stop selling salads at impacted restaurants until they switched to another lettuce supplier. Nearly 3,000 restaurants in 14 states (IL, IA, IN, WI, MI, OH, MN, NE, SD, MT, ND, KY, WV, and MO) may be impacted.

Cyclosporiasis is reportable in South Dakota. Of the individuals with *Cyclospora* infections reported to the SD-DOH, two (2) have recalled consuming McDonald's salad prior to their illness onset.
