




Therefore, the Board, according to the disciplinary procedures outlined in ARSD 20:48:08, issues this Letter of Reprimand. In addition, the Board will require you to complete learning modules: (1) The NCSBN **Righting a Wrong: Ethics and Professionalism in Nursing**, (2) NCSBN **Documentation A Critical Aspect of Client-Care**, and (3) RN.com **Focused Physical Examination for Acute Care Settings**. You are responsible to purchase and complete these modules and return certificates of successful completion to the Board office no later than August 20, 2014.

This final action is reportable discipline and will be published in the Board's newsletter, posted on its website, and reported into the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB) as required by law. As this is a reportable discipline, you are required to provide an affirmative response to inquiries of disciplinary action on further renewals and other nursing related inquiries.
