Dear Ms. Pederson:

It has come to the attention of the South Dakota Board of Nursing that you have unlawfully practiced as a nurse in the state of South Dakota for more than fourteen months. In order to practice as a nurse in the state of South Dakota, you must be licensed in accordance with SDCL 36-9-2.

The SD Board of Nursing notified you by mail 11/24/2009 that you were issued a Letter of Concern and your SD license was inactivated. From February through September 2009, you were counseled at least four times by SD Board of Nursing staff that you must obtain nursing licensure in the state you reside. As of yet, you have failed to obtain this licensure. Be advised: unlawful practice in this State is prohibited and constitutes grounds for criminal prosecution.

This letter serves as a notice to you to cease and desist from any further violation of SDCL 36-9-2 in the state of South Dakota; unless you become licensed by your State of residence. If the Boards discover that, without a proper license, you have practiced or offered to practice as a nurse, or indicated that you are licensed as a nurse in this State, formal action will be pursued to enforce the Boards' legal remedies.
