


Regulations, a Licensee mandated into such a program as HPAP shall be granted a single state license only. This license certificate will be sent to you by the Board.

Your participation in HPAP is mandatory in order for you to maintain an active, single state license in the state of South Dakota. To meet this mandate, you must be enrolled and demonstrating active participation within sixty (60) days of this letter. Failure to comply with any aspect of this program and its contract will result in additional disciplinary action by the South Dakota Board of Nursing.

This final action is reportable discipline and will be published in the Board's newsletter, posted on its web site, and reported into the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB) as required by law. As this is a reportable discipline, you are required to provide an affirmative response to inquiries of disciplinary action on further renewals and other nursing related inquiries.
