The Board of Nursing called Licensee as part of its case in chief. Approximately one hour into her examination, a recess was requested by Licensee's counsel. Thereafter, Licensee and her counsel returned and on the record conceded that the Board had met its burden of proof for the continued suspension of the Licensee's license. The hearing thereafter was deemed concluded at approximately 2:15 p.m.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That the Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over the Licensee and the subject matter of this order.
2. That the Licensee's license to practice nursing in the State of South Dakota and her privilege to practice nursing pursuant to the Nurse Compact are hereby suspended for an indefinite period of time.
3. That the Licensee may petition for a reinstatement of her license at any time for "good cause" pursuant to SDCL § 36-9-57 as the Board of Nursing in its discretion may determine.
4. That the Licensee shall turn in her license to the Board of Nursing within ten (10) day from the date of this order.
5. That the Licensee is hereby notified that any practice as or holding herself out as a registered nurse during the term of this suspension is a violation of SDCL § 36-9-68.

6. That the Licensee is required to reimburse the South Dakota Board of Nursing herein for actual expenses incurred as a result of this action as provided in SDCL § 1-26-29.1 in the sum of \$0.00.

7. That the parties hereby waive Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law based on the Licensee's conceding the case against her.


