



SD EMS Driver's Competencies Form

SDCL 44:05:03, allows for ambulance services in South Dakota to have at a minimum one EMT/ALS Provider and one driver as part of every ambulance response. The driver must meet certain requirements to be eligible to work for a licensed ambulance service. These requirements are noted below. For a more detailed description of the requirements and available resources, please visit EMS.sd.gov.

The service director must maintain record of each candidate successfully completing the state approved "Driver" competencies course. This document will serve such purposes and will be made available upon request by the Department.

The following competencies have been identified as part of the driver training.

- CPR
- HIPAA Awareness
- Infection Control
- Patient Movement
- Equipment and Communications Systems Knowledge
- Emergency Vehicle Operations Course
