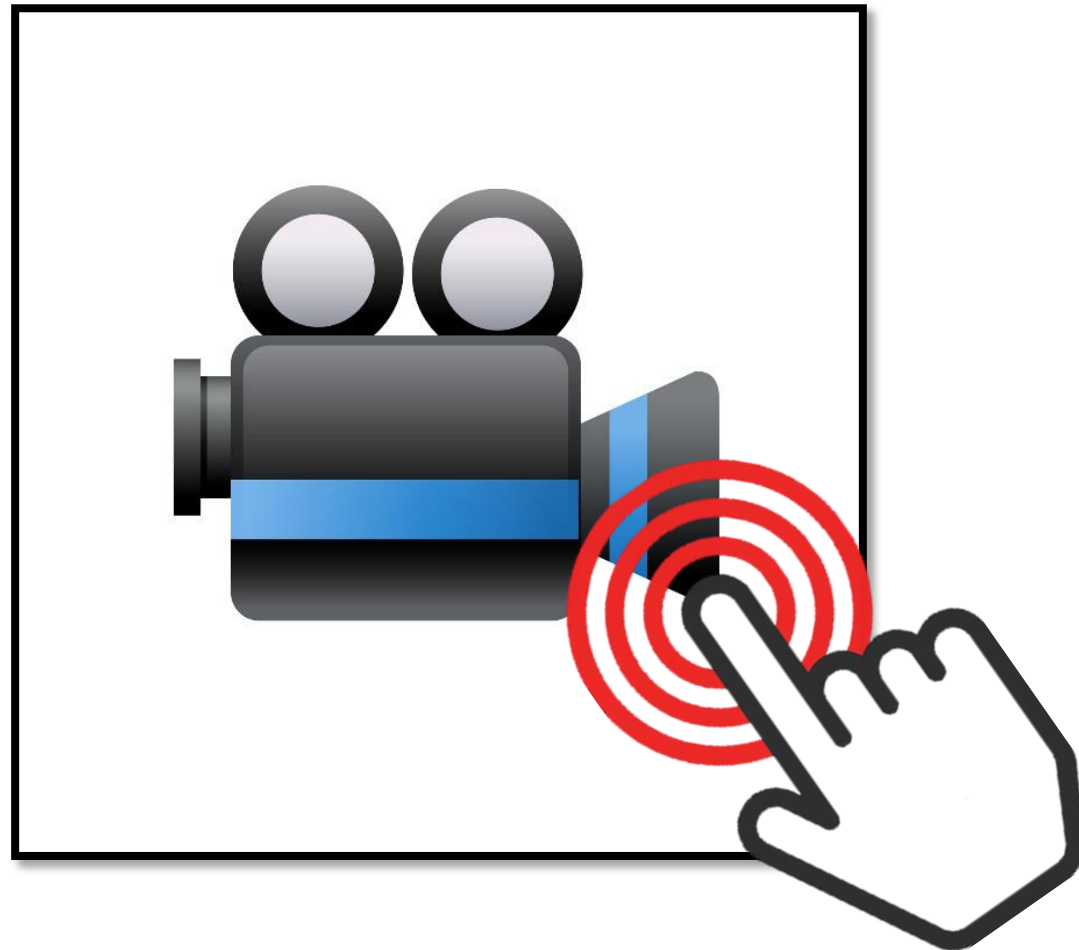

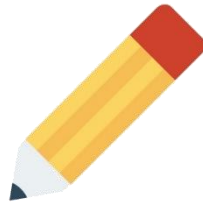

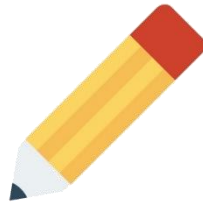
Main Functions of POD



- *Greeting & Triage*
- *Screening*
- *Dispensing*



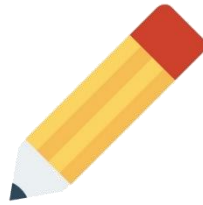
Main Function 1: Greeting and Triage



- *Greet individuals entering the POD*
- *Assist clients in completing screening forms*
- *Send to correct next station*



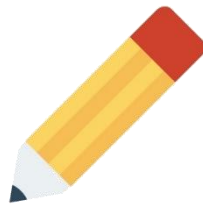
Main Function 2: Screening



- *Determine which MCM (if any) to be given*
- *Direct clients to dispensing*

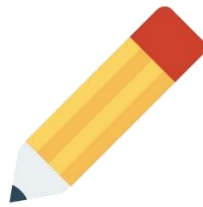


Main Function 3: Dispensing



- *Identify MCM marked by screener*
- *Individuals receive*
 - *MCMs*
 - *Health information handouts*
- *Direct individuals to the exit*

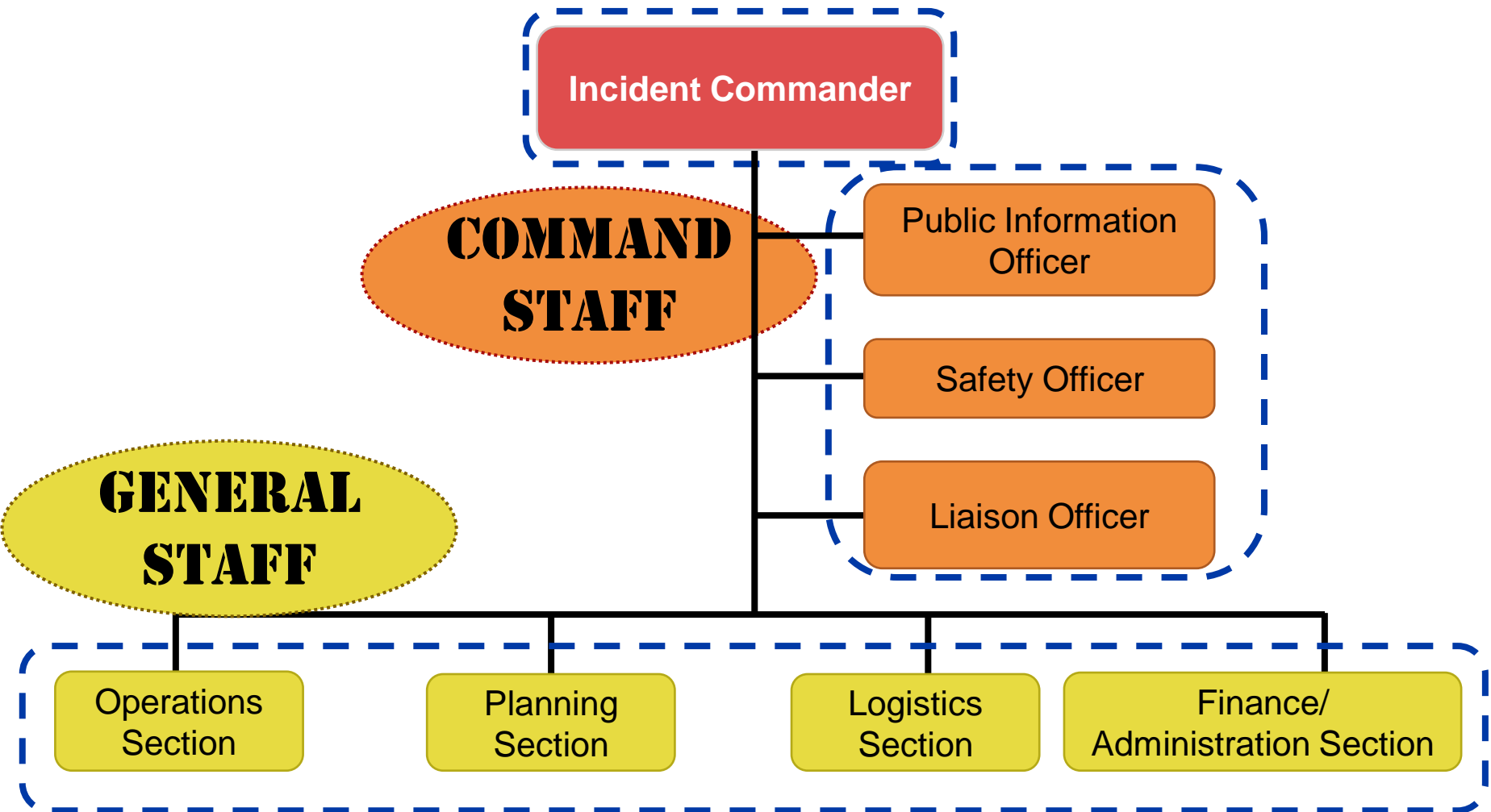

Guidelines for working together during emergencies

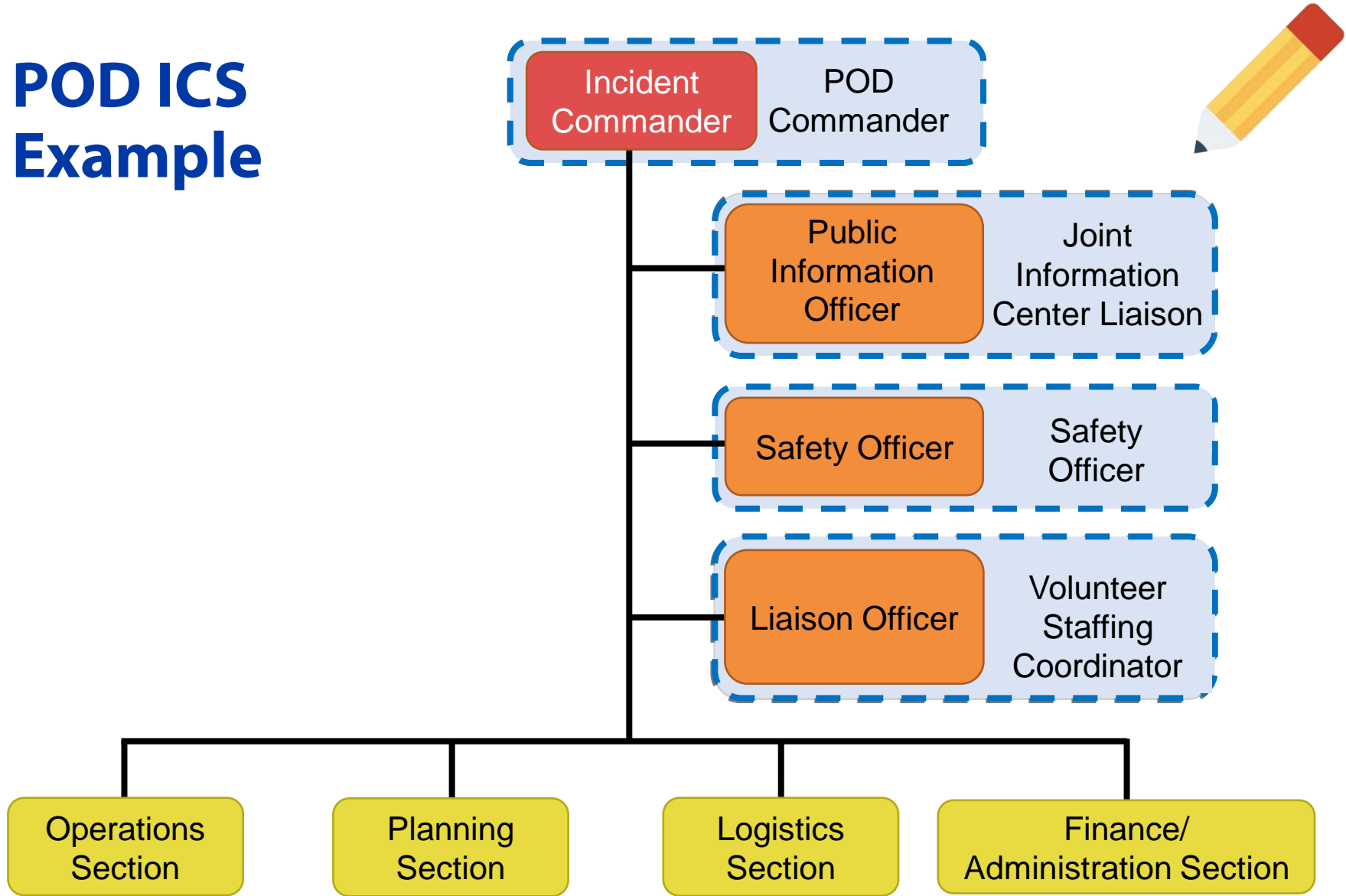
- *Common terminology*

- *Span of control (3-7 people)*



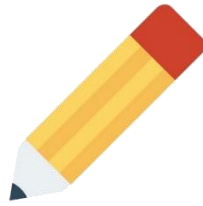
Incident Command System (ICS)
