

#### **Main Functions of POD**

- Greeting & Triage
- Screening
- Dispensing



## **Main Function 1: Greeting and Triage**



- Greet individuals entering the POD
- Assist clients in completing screening forms
- Send to correct next station



## **Main Function 2: Screening**



- Determine which MCM (if any) to be given
- Direct clients to dispensing



## **Main Function 3: Dispensing**





- Identify MCM marked by screener
- Individuals receive
  - MCMs
  - Health information handouts
- Direct individuals to the exit




Guidelines for working together during emergencies
