




PODs

 Local <u>P</u>oints <u>of</u> <u>D</u>ispensing (PODs) are designated sites throughout the state that would be set up quickly to dispense emergency pharmaceuticals. (Vaccines, Antibiotics, Antidotes)

- Goal to reach the entire state within 48 hours of activation.
- Community effort



POD Sizes

There are 4 sizes of PODs, each with a capacity to serve a certain size jurisdiction, thus a Level "A" POD will have the resources to serve up to 50,000 people within the goal of 48 hours; and a Level "D" POD would be scaled to serve up to 10,000 people within 48 hours.

Level "A": (50,000 treated/48hrs)

Level "B": (30,000 treated/48hrs)


Level "C": (20,000 treated/48hrs)

Level "D": (10,000 treated/48hrs)




So. Dakota PODS by the Counties They Serve


So. Dakota Polits of Dispensing by the Counties They Serve




National repository of antibiotics, chemical antidotes, antitoxins, lifesupport medications, IV administration, airway maintenance supplies, and medical/surgical items.








