- There is no nationwide median for never having been tested for HIV


Healthy People 2010 Objective

There was no stated Healthy People 2010 Objective for never been tested for HIV.

Trend Analysis

This question was first asked in 1993 with 83.3 percent of respondents stating they have never had an HIV test. In recent years, the percent of respondents who have never had an HIV test has been decreasing slightly from 78.9 percent in 2006 to 76.5 percent in 2010.
