On September 29, 2017 the South Dakota Public Health Laboratory (SDPHL) will discontinue select viral serologic testing. The SDPHL will continue to provide HIV, hepatitis A, hepatitis B, and hepatitis C serologic testing. Additionally, the SDPHL will continue to maintain a robust serologic testing program for vaccine preventable viral diseases including measles, mumps, rubella, varicella zoster, and influenza.
