

**South Dakota Board of Chiropractic Examiners Meeting
Teleconference Meeting
December 6, 2017**

Marcia Walter presented the financial update. The state account currently has a balance of \$312,662.37 as of November 30, 2017. Renewals are in process. With no additions or corrections, the board received the financial update as presented.

M/S McCracken/Goebel to approve preceptor application of Arielle Loveridge with Dr. Lee Eklund

Passed, no opposition

M/S Goebel/Odland approve matriculant 12601 pending completion of file

Passed, no opposition – applicant will be required to submit the matriculation quiz prior to licensure and also attend the March matriculation meeting. Failure to do so may result in revocation.
