6. This matter is an adversarial proceeding and the Licensee has the right to be present at the hearing and to be represented by an attorney. These due process rights will be forfeited if they are not exercised at the hearing.

7. Licensee has the right to request that the agency use the Office of Hearing Examiners for this proceeding by giving notice of the request to the Board no later than ten (10) days after service of this Notice of Hearing on Order of Summary Suspension.

8. The decision issued by the Board after the hearing may be appealed to the Circuit Court in the State Supreme Court as provided by law.


