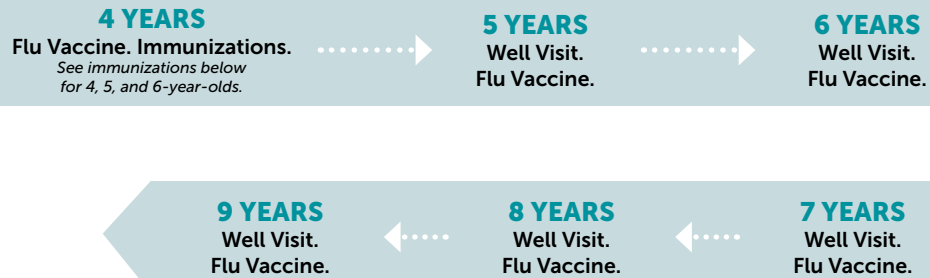

RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATIONS



- ✓ **Tdap*** (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)
- ✓ **MMR*** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- ✓ **Flu** (Influenza) - Annually
- ✓ **IPV*** (Inactivated polio)
- ✓ **Varicella*** (Chicken Pox)

**Can be given between 4 and 6 years old.*



DENTAL EXAM

Keep smiles healthy with an annual dental exam and two cleanings per year.
