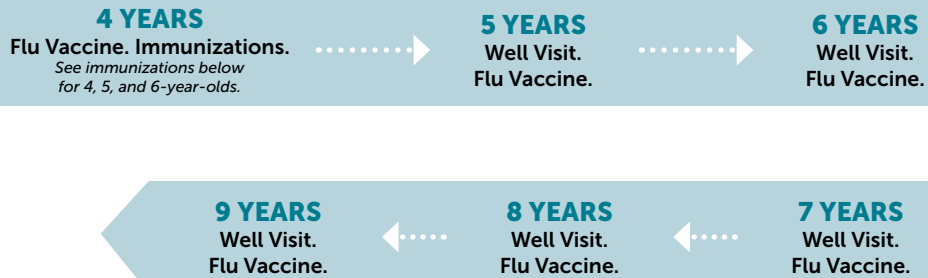

## WELL VISIT AND IMMUNIZATION ROAD MAP



### RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATIONS

- ✓ **Tdap\*** (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)
- ✓ **MMR\*** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- ✓ **Flu** (Influenza) - Annually
- ✓ **IPV\*** (Inactivated polio)
- ✓ **Varicella\*** (Chicken Pox)

*\*Can be given between 4 and 6 years old.*



### DENTAL EXAM

Keep smiles healthy with an annual dental exam and two cleanings per year.
