Awareness of Measles Detection in Brookings County

Counties: Brookings, Deuel, Hamlin, Kingsbury, Lake, Moody

Situation: Measles has been detected in a child from **Brookings County**. The South Dakota Department of Health (SD-DOH) asks medical providers to be alert for patients with potential exposure to measles or patients presenting with [measles symptoms](#) (fever, cough, runny nose, or red, watery eyes). SD-DOH staff are available for consultation by calling 800-592-1861. Measles is a Category I disease which should be reported to SD-DOH immediately upon suspicion.
