





SD Opioid Prescriptions




Opioid Prescriptions YOY in SD




Top Ten CS YOY by Rx Count

2015 2016 2017




Top Ten CS YOY by Dispensed Quantity

 - Daily active morphine milligram equivalents (MME)

Prescriber Reports

- Provide quarterly reports based on the last six month period and will inform the prescriber on their own prescribing history including:
 - Comparison to red flag indicators and to peers in their specialty field
 - Summary of patient and prescription volumes
 - Notification of potential multiple provider episodes
 - Summary of prescriber and delegate PDMP utilization

Drug Take-Back Program

- Establishment of the MedDrop Program in SD retail pharmacies by the Board of Pharmacy
- Operational in 9 pharmacies; current funding available for 15 pharmacies
 - Lewis Family Drug Milbank, Chamberlain, De Smet, Viborg
 - Lewis Drug Madison
 - Lewis Drug Southgate Sioux Falls
 - Lynn's Dakotamart Pierre
 - Randall Pharmacy Redfield
 - Cornwell Drug Webster
- 555 pounds have been collected and returned for destruction since October 2017
- Establishing SD master site list with DOH and 211 Helpline
