The above-captioned matter came before the South Dakota Board of Funeral Service (Board) on November 17, 2022. Taylor C. Oster did not appear personally or through counsel. Board staff was present and represented by Assistant Attorney General Megan Borchert. The Board being otherwise fully informed of the facts and issues pertinent to this matter issues the following:

The Board hereby

FINDS that on September 16, 2022, Taylor C. Oster signed a consent to voluntarily surrender his South Dakota Funeral Director/Embalmer license number 1388. The Board further

FINDS that on September 14, 2022, Taylor C. Oster signed a consent to transfer funeral establishment licenses numbers 161 and 162 to Charles R. Rooks

Based on the foregoing, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Board accepts the voluntary surrender of the South Dakota Funeral Director/Embalmer license number 1388 of Taylor C. Oster. Said license is deemed to be surrendered effective September 16, 2022, pursuant to the terms of the


consent. It is further

ORDERED that the Board accepts the transfer of funeral establishment licenses numbers 161 and 162 from Taylor C. Oster to Charles R. Rooks. Said transfer is deemed to be effective September 14, 2022, pursuant to the terms of the consent. It is further

ORDERED that the Board adopts the terms of both the consent to voluntarily surrender and the consent to transfer funeral establishment licenses, incorporated herein by reference, and that the parties are bound by the terms set forth therein. It is further

ORDERED that the Board will therefore close its file regarding the pending complaint proceedings without further action and shall report the Order as necessary or deemed appropriate by the Board in accordance with State and Federal law.
