S 106	44:70:02:06 Food Service A facility of seventeen beds or more shall have a mechanical dishwasher. The facility shall have the space, equipment, supplies and mechanical systems for efficient, safe, and sanitary food preparation if any part of the food service is provided by the facility. This Administrative Rule of South Dakota is not met as evidenced by: Based on observation, interview, record review, policy review, and manufacturer's installation manual review, the provider failed to maintain the dishwasher wash cycle temperature at a minimum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit (F) for one of one dishwasher. Findings include: 1. Observation and interview on 7/7/26 at 9:20 a.m. with cook C in the kitchen revealed an American Dish Service dishwasher was used to clean the dishes. The dishwasher temperature log documented 115 degrees F for the wash and rinse cycles for 7/1/26 through 7/7/26. Cook C stated the dishwasher temperatures were recorded twice a day and needed to be 115 degrees F at a minimum. Cook C ran a tray of dishes through the dishwasher and the	S 106	1. All residents are at risk. The facility removed the mechanical dishwasher from service upon identification that it was not consistently achieving the required minimum wash temperature of 120 degrees F. All dishwashing operations were transitioned to a three-compartment sink process utilizing approved manual wash, rinse, and sanitization procedures in accordance	8/22/2026

She stated she would contact maintenance director D if there was an issue with the dishwasher. 2. Interview on 7/7/26 at 3:00 p.m. with maintenance director D revealed he did check the dishwasher temperature as part of his weekly routine. He was unaware the wash temperature needed to be a minimum of 120 degrees F. 3. Interview on 7/8/26 at 8:30 a.m. with administrator A revealed he knew the dishwasher wash temperature needed to be 120 degrees F. He ran the dishwasher multiple times after lunch on 7/7/26 and the highest reading was 116 degrees F. He confirmed the dishwasher was not reaching the minimum temperature of 120 degrees F. 4. Review of the dishwasher temperature logs for May, June, and July revealed none of the documented temperatures reached 120 degrees F. 5. Review of the dishwasher manufacturer's installation instructions revealed, "Water heaters or boilers must provide the minimum temperature of 120F for these models." 6. Review of the provider's 2020 Guideline and Procedure for Dishwashing policy revealed, "The Dining Service staff shall maintain the operation of the dishwashing machine according to established procedure and manufacturer guidelines posted or contained in this guideline to ensure effective cleaning and sanitization of all tableware and equipment use in the preparation and service of food." "e. Monitor that the dishwashing machine is maintaining operating guidelines for wash, rinse,	S 106	with manufacturer guidelines and applicable food safety standards. Disposable paper products are being utilized as appropriate to reduce dishwashing volume while corrective measures are completed. Facility is working with contractors to repair/replace the dishwasher. The facility will receive the bid and schedule work by 8/22/26 to be completed at the contractor's earliest availability. The facility will verify proper operation, including achievement of the required minimum wash temperature, prior to returning the dishwasher to service. 2.The Administrator or designee will educate the staff regarding manufacturer temperature requirements, proper monitoring of dishwashing equipment, and procedures for removing equipment from service when operational parameters are not met on or before 8/22/2026. 3. The Administrator or designee will conduct and document audits of the manual dishwashing and sanitization process weekly for four weeks and monthly thereafter for two months. Once the dishwasher is repaired and returned to service, dishwasher temperature logs will be reviewed weekly for four weeks and monthly for two months to ensure compliance with manufacturer specifications and facility policy. Audit results will be reviewed through the facility's QAPI process, for further review, progress and recommendations.
