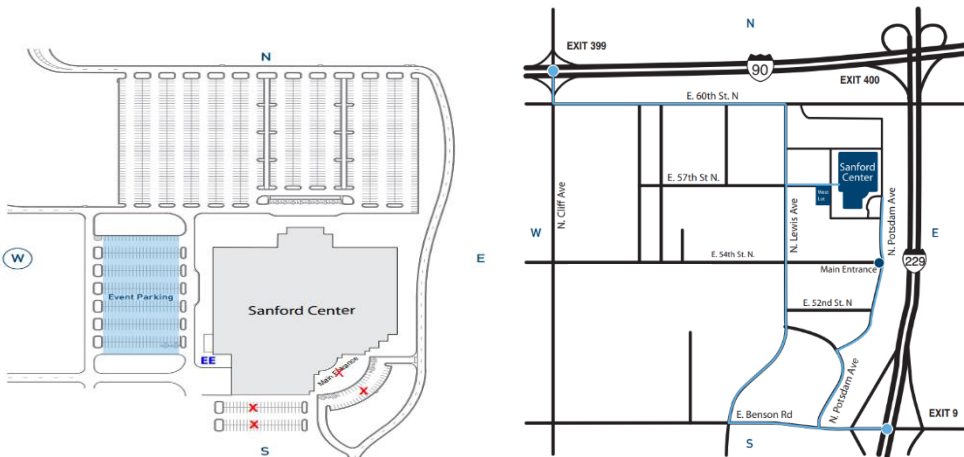
Room temperatures tend to fluctuate, bring a light jacket/sweater for comfort.
