What to Expect at a **Reproductive Health Visit**

Seeing any health professional can feel intimidating, but it can be helpful to know what to expect at your appointment. The following advice and expectations are based on common experiences; however, every appointment will be different based on the provider and your own needs and concerns.

BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT

- Take notes on symptoms leading up to the appointment
- Bring a list of questions
- If you would be comfortable, bring a trusted adult to help advocate for you

DURING YOUR APPOINTMENT

- A nurse or medical assistant will take your vitals and ask for a basic health history
- A medical professional will ask why you made the appointment - this is a good time to mention any concerns or symptoms
- The provider may ask to conduct an exam and should explain why an exam is recommended
- Ask any questions that may come up. If you forget to ask a question, you can always call or send a message later





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
