

Definitions

Sexual Violence

A sexual act that is committed or attempted by another person without freely given consent of the victim or against someone who is unable to consent or refuse.

Sexual Assault

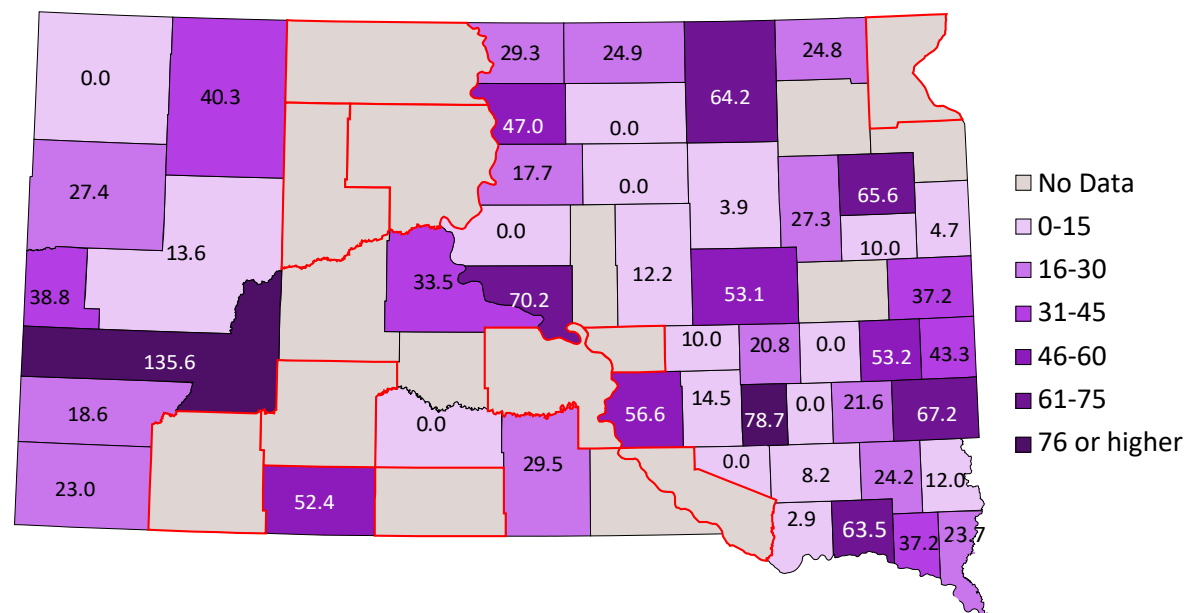
Sexual contact or behavior that occurs without explicit consent of the victim and includes attempted rape, fondling/unwanted sexual touching, forcing a victim to perform sexual acts, and rape.

Rape

The penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim.

SD Rape Rates by County¹



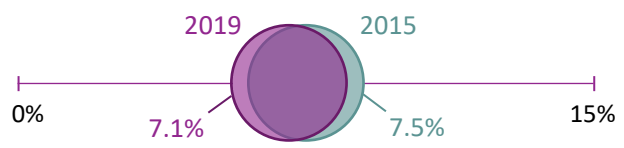
Map does not include data for reservation and off-reservation tribal trust lands. Significant portions of the counties outlined in red are tribal land.

Sexual Violence Among Youth³

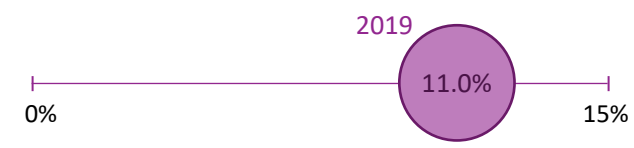
Ever physically forced to have sex

Experienced sexual violence by anyone (2019 data is only year available)



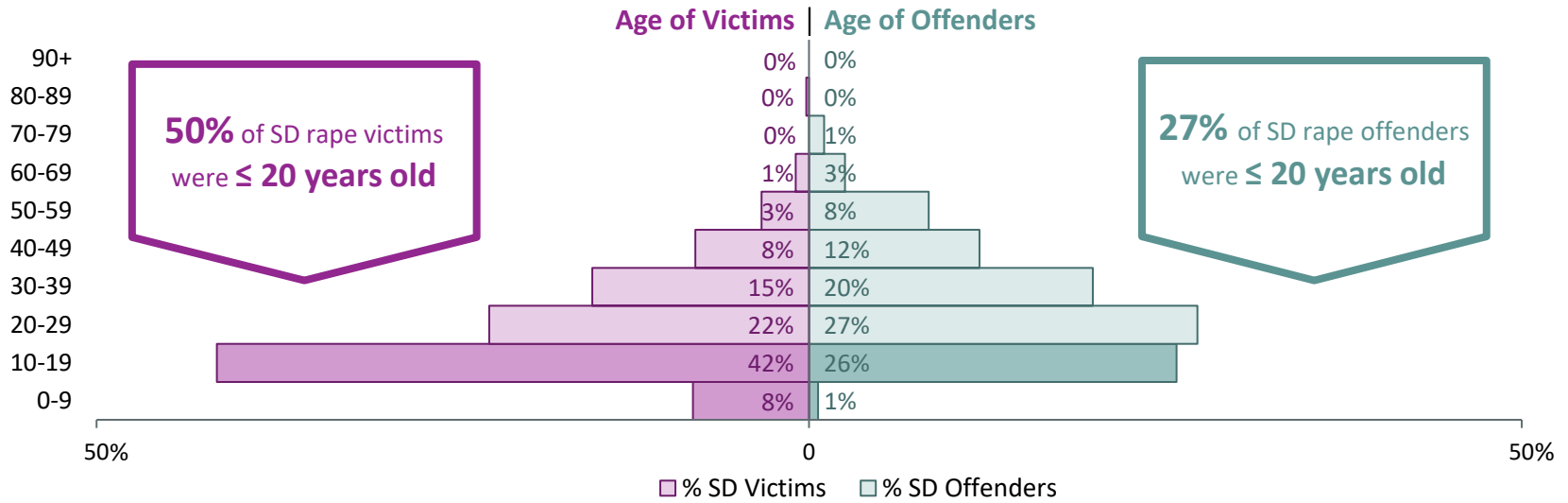

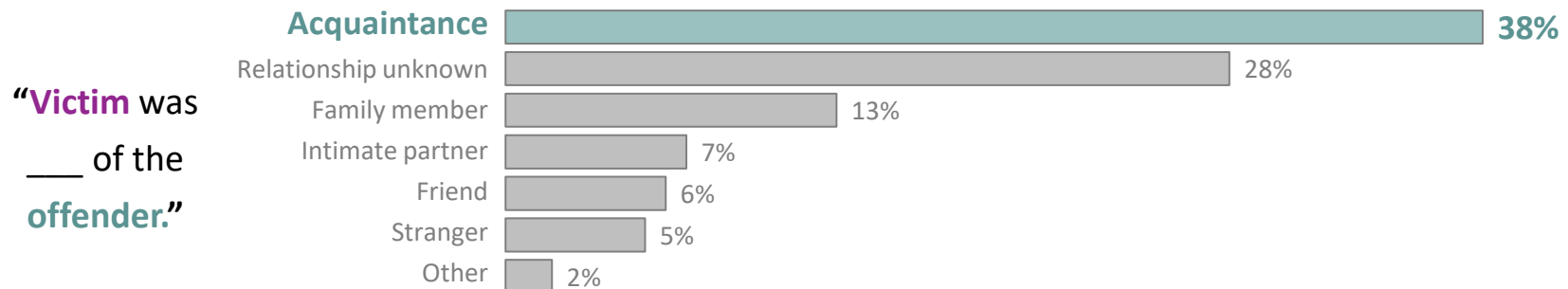
