
594 people are estimated to be living with HIV/AIDS in South Dakota.


Disproportionately impacted by HIV/AIDS:

- Blacks: 23% of living cases, 1% of the population.
- Native Americans: 16% of living cases, 9% of the population.

Late Testers: Persons who are diagnosed with AIDS within 12 months of their initial HIV diagnosis, were 30% of all cases, 2010 through 2016.

South Dakota Residents Reported Infected with HIV/AIDS: Cumulative Cases by County, 1985 - 2016





At the end of 2016, 833 SD residents had been reported as infected with HIV (617 male, 216 female) and 435 of those had also been diagnosed with AIDS. Some cases may have been reported as an HIV case in a different year than they were diagnosed with AIDS.
