Irregular Menstruation

Are you concerned about the symptoms your cycle is creating? Here's how to determine when to see a provider.

CONSULT A PROVIDER

Cramps that are bad enough to miss school, even with medication

COMMON SYMPTOMS

Cramps that are significantly reduced by over the counter medication

Pain inserting a tampon after practicing for several cycles

2

Some pain the first few times using a tampon

Soaking through a pad/tampon every hour for several hours in a row, or having to change the pad in the middle of the night



Changing a pad/tampon 3-5 times a day

Having a previously regular period, after menstruating for more than 2 years, stop for more than 3 months



Having irregular periods throughout the first two years after onset

Passing large blood clots, having a period longer than 7 days, extreme change in ones emotions during certain times of your cycle



Mild cramps, mood swings, sore breasts, acne and feeling more emotional than usual during certain times of your cycle
