RE: South Dakota Public Health Laboratory Forensic Evidence Retention

The South Dakota Public Health Laboratory has the following policy for evidence retention:

Blood Samples are kept for two years from the date of submission.

Urine Samples are kept for **two years** from the date of submission.

Seized Drug Evidence is kept for **two years** from the date of submission.

If you need any evidence retained for longer than the destruction date, please contact the South Dakota Public Health Laboratory via email Lona.HaasBoyer@state.sd.us. If a case is still pending more than two years from the date of submission, a new request must be made every year to ensure the sample is not destroyed.
