



### **Bright Start Nurse Home Visiting Program**

Supporting first-time pregnant women and young families, Bright Start connects clients with trained nurses. who provide health guidance, emotional support, and resources from pregnancy through a child's second birthday.

These outcomes show that personalized, trusted support leads to higher healthcare engagement and better longterm health habits—even after the program ends.

# How Nurse Home Visiting Improves Health Outcomes

CY2024 Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS) Measure Comparison Bright Start Home Visiting Program enrollees vs. South Dakota Medicaid enrollees

#### **Prenatal Care**

**HEDIS Definition:** Percentage of deliveries on or between October 8 of 2023 thru October 7 of 2024 that had a prenatal care visit in the first trimester or within 42 days of Medicaid enrollment.

**Bright Start Client HEDIS Value:** 118/233 = 50.6%

**Medicaid (Overall) Population HEDIS Value:** 1501/3006 = 49.9%

Bright Start nurse home visiting enrolls first-time pregnant women at any point during their pregnancy. Because this Bright Start enrollment frequently happens after the first trimester, we would not expect the program to impact this measure

#### **Well Child Visit Completion (15 months)**

**HEDIS Definition:** Percentage of children who turned age 15 months in 2024 that had six or more well-child visits with a primary care provider during the last 15 months.

**Bright Start Client HEDIS Value:** 107/148 = 72.3%

Medicaid (Overall) Population HEDIS Value: 1640/3651 = 44.9%

We can "assume" from the increase in healthcare access shown between first prenatal visit and well-child care visits could possibly be attributed to the support of a Bright Start nurse in encouraging families to access healthcare


#### **Well Child Visit Completion (30 months)**

**HEDIS Definition:** Percentage of children who turned age 30 months in 2024 that had two or more well-child visits with a primary care provider during the last 15 months.

**Bright Start Client HEDIS Value:** 24/27 = 88.9%

**Medicaid (Overall) Population HEDIS Value:** 1650/3243 = 50.9%

Continued effects of families accessing healthcare even after Bright Start enrollment ends (graduation at 24 months)



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
