HIV Program

Received Notice of Award for the federal high impact prevention and surveillance programs for health departments, and started our 1 year of our five year cycle in August of 2024. This year one funding cycle ends May 31st, 2025.

Submitted out budget for year 2 and are awaiting our notice of award.

Make America Healthy Again: Administration for a healthy America (AHA)

The branches eliminated within the Division of HIV Prevention were: Prevention Communication, Behavioral & Clinical Surveillance, Capacity Development, Qualitative Sciences, and HIV Research.

Heartland health expanding statewide (absorbing VOA)

STD Program

Received their full award in April 2025.

At the request of the Great Plains Area HIS, Commissioned Corps Officers were deployed to SD to continue efforts in reducing syphilis. The officers were stationed in the state for a duration of 90 days, beginning in Jan 2025. During the initial 60 days, the teams were strategically assigned to four service unit areas most significantly impacted by syphilis. Their primary focus was on providing boots on the ground support in Pine Ridge, Eagle Butte, Rosebud, and Rapid City area, conducting field visits, and identifying who had tested positive or has been exposed to offer testing and treatment services. In addition, several educational outreach efforts were carried out, and testing was enhanced during scheduled health fairs and walk-in clinics.
