Immobilization Devices

- ☐ Ambulance cot with mattress
- ☐ Cervical collars (adult & pediatric)
- ☐ Immobilization-upper & lower extremity (adult & pediatric)
- ☐ Head immobilization device
- ☐ Pediatric immobilization device
- ☐ Short immobilization device
- ☐ Spine board with 3 straps

Infection Control Equipment

- ☐ Bio-hazard bags
- ☐ Disinfectant for cleaning
- ☐ Eye & face protections
- ☐ Gown/jumpsuits (fluid-resistant)
- ☐ Hand wash - Antimicrobial
- ☐ Masks - HEPA
- ☐ Sharps container
- ☐ Trash bags

Medications

- ☐ Aspirin - adult 81 mg/baby aspirin
- ☐ Glucose
- ☐ Oxygen
- ☐ Anaphylaxis medication (recommended)
- ☐ Opioid antagonist (recommended)

Obstetric kit

- ☐ OB Kit – 1) towels; 2) bulb suction; 3) sterile pads/dressings; 4) plastic bags/basin; 5) cord clamps/tape/ties; 6) sterile scissors/scalpel; 7) sterile gloves; 8) thermal blanket & head cover; 9) APGAR chart.
