**Definition:** Respondents that report they have never had an HIV test.


## Prevalence of Never Been Tested for HIV

## Healthy People 2020 Objective


There was no stated Healthy People 2020 Objective for never having been tested for HIV.

### **Further Analysis**

The following data show the percentages of those who have never been tested for HIV for various health behaviors and conditions. For example, 64 percent of respondents who have depression have never been tested for HIV, while 77 percent of respondents who do not have depression have never been tested for HIV.
