


Arthritis, 2016

Respondents who answered “yes” to the question: “Have you ever been told by a doctor or other health professional that you have some form of arthritis, rheumatoid arthritis, gout, lupus, or fibromyalgia?”

The national median for having arthritis is 25.8 percent. South Dakota has 25.8 percent of respondents stating they have some form of arthritis.

Washington D.C. has the lowest with 16.9 percent, while West Virginia has the highest with 38.9 percent of respondents who have some form of arthritis.
