


# Asthma, 2016

Respondents who were told by a doctor, nurse, or other health professional that they had asthma and that they still have asthma.

The national median for having asthma is 9.3 percent.

South Dakota has the lowest with 6.2 percent, while Maine has the highest with 12.2 percent of respondents who have asthma.
