


Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease, 2016

Respondents who answered “yes” to the question: “Has a doctor, nurse, or other health professional ever told you that you have Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease, or COPD, emphysema or chronic bronchitis?”

The national median for having COPD is 6.3 percent. South Dakota has 5.2 percent of respondents stating they have COPD.

Utah has the lowest with 3.9 percent, while West Virginia has the highest with 13.9 percent of respondents who have COPD.
