


Cancer, 2016

Respondents who reported they had ever been diagnosed with cancer (excluding skin cancer).

The national median for having ever been diagnosed with cancer (excluding skin cancer) is 6.7 percent. South Dakota has 7.0 percent of respondents who report they have ever been diagnosed with cancer (excluding skin cancer).

Washington D.C. has the lowest with 4.2 percent, while Montana has the highest with 8.6 percent of respondents who report they have ever been diagnosed with cancer (excluding skin cancer).


Skin Cancer, 2016

Respondents who reported they had ever been diagnosed with skin cancer.

The national median for having ever been diagnosed with skin cancer is 5.9 percent. South Dakota has 6.3 percent of respondents who report they have ever been diagnosed with skin cancer.

Alaska has the lowest with 2.7 percent, while Florida has the highest with 9.1 percent of respondents who report they have ever been diagnosed with skin cancer.
