


Diabetes, 2016

Respondents ever told by a doctor that they have diabetes, excluding women who were told this while they were pregnant.

The national median for diabetes is 10.5 percent. South Dakota has 7.9 percent of respondents who report they have diabetes.

Colorado has the lowest with 6.6 percent, while West Virginia has the highest with 15.0 percent of respondents who report they have diabetes.
