


Fair or Poor Health, 2016

Respondents who report having fair or poor health from possible response choices of “excellent”, “very good”, “good”, “fair”, or “poor”.

The national median for fair or poor health is 16.4 percent. South Dakota has 13.0 percent of respondents who report fair or poor health.

Washington D.C. has the lowest with 11.6 percent, while West Virginia has the highest with 26.3 percent of respondents who report fair or poor health.
