

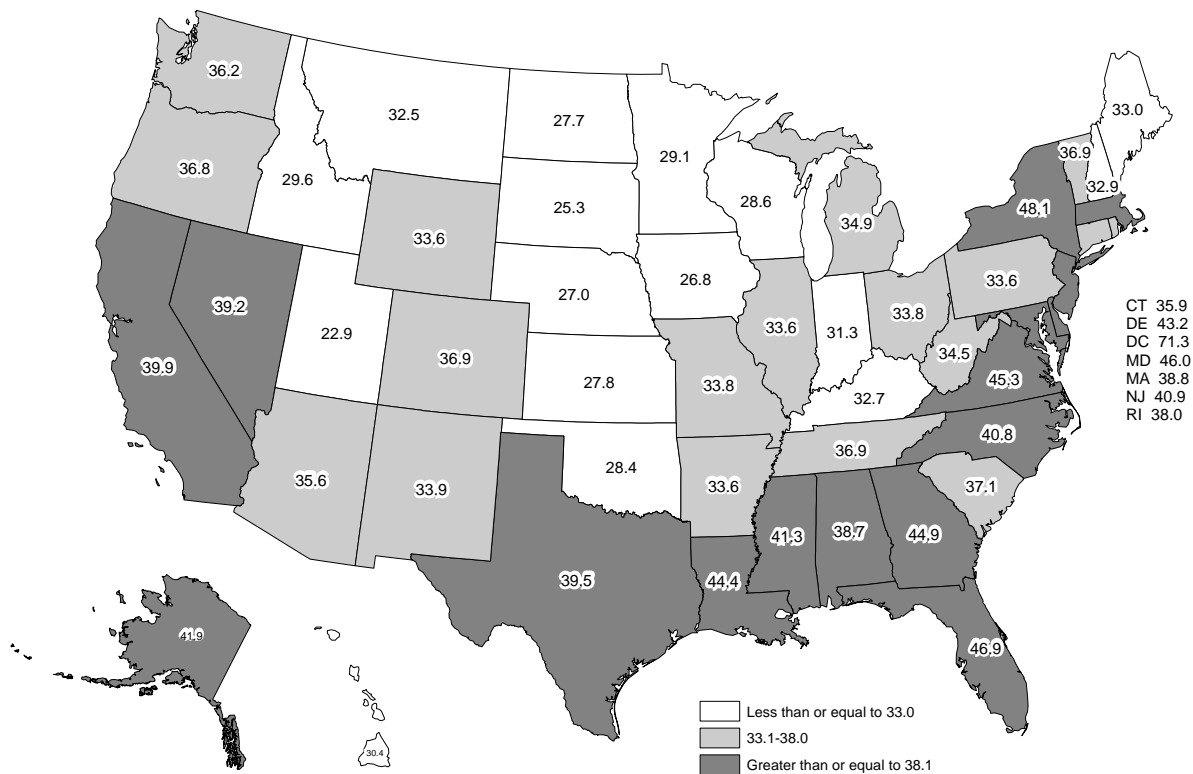
HIV Test, 2016

Respondents, ages 18-64, that report they have had an HIV test.

The national median for respondents, ages 18-64, who have been tested for HIV is 35.6 percent. South Dakota has 25.3 percent of respondents, ages 18-64, who have been tested for HIV.

Utah has the lowest with 22.9 percent, while Washington D.C. has the highest with 71.3 percent of respondents, ages 18-64, who have been tested for HIV.
