


Flu Shot, 2016

Respondents aged 65 and older, who have had an influenza vaccination within the past 12 months.

The national median for having a flu shot, aged 65 and older, is 58.6 percent. South Dakota has 63.5 percent of respondents aged 65 and older, who report they have had a flu shot within the past 12 months.

Wisconsin has the lowest with 49.5 percent, while West Virginia has the highest with 67.5 percent of respondents aged 65 and older, who report they have had a flu shot within the past 12 months.


Pneumonia Shot, 2016

Respondents aged 65 and older who have had a pneumonia vaccination.

The national median for having a pneumonia shot, aged 65 and older, is 73.4 percent. South Dakota has 75.8 percent of respondents aged 65 and older, who report they have had a pneumonia shot.

Washington D.C. has the lowest with 64.4 percent, while New Hampshire has the highest with 79.8 percent of respondents aged 65 and older, who report they have had a pneumonia shot.
