


Kidney Disease, 2016

Respondents who answered “yes” to the question: “Has a doctor, nurse, or other health professional ever told you that you have kidney disease? Do NOT include kidney stones, bladder infection or incontinence.”

The national median for having kidney disease is 2.8 percent. South Dakota has 2.4 percent of respondents who have kidney disease.

Wyoming has the lowest with 1.8 percent, while Mississippi has the highest with 4.0 percent of respondents who have kidney disease.
