Unintentional Injury (by grade)

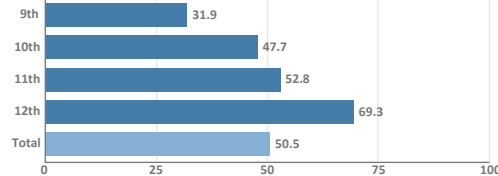
Percent of students who rarely or never wear a seat belt when riding in a car



Percent of students who in the past 30 days rode one or more times in a car or other vehicle driven by someone who had been drinking alcohol

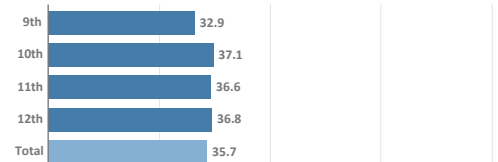


Among students who drove a car in the past 30 days, the percentage who texted or emailed while driving

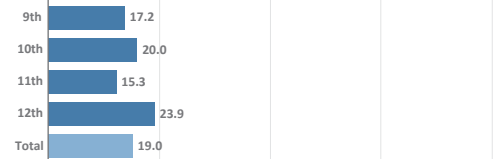


Suicide (by grade)

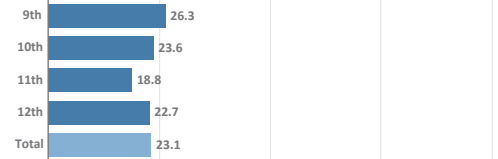
In the past 12 months, the percent of students who felt so sad or hopeless almost every day for two or more weeks in a row that they stopped doing their usual activities



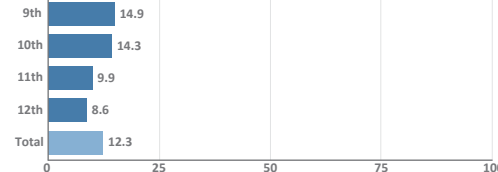
Percent of students who most of the time or always get the help they need when they feel sad, empty, hopeless, angry, or anxious



Percent of students who seriously considered attempting suicide in the past 12 months

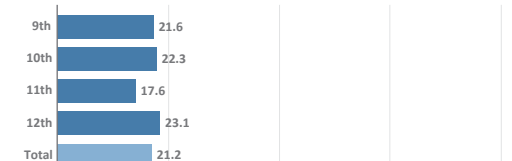


Percent of students who attempted suicide one or more times in the past 12 months

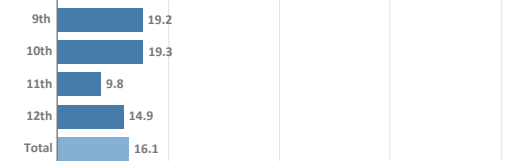

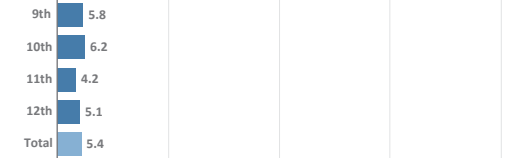
Percent of students who were bullied on school property in the past 12 months



Percent of students who were electronically bullied in the past 12 months



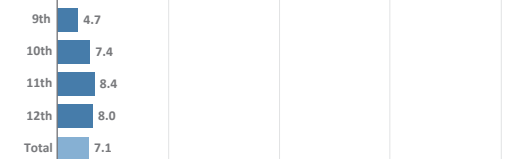
Percent of students who had a revealing or sexual photo texted, emailed, or posted electronically without their permission in the past 12 months



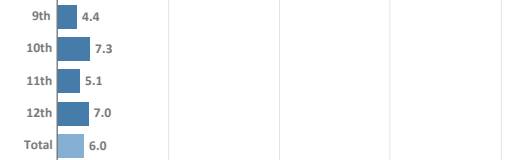
Percent of students who have ever been forced to do sexual things when they did not want to (i.e. kissing, touching, but not sexual intercourse)

Percent of students forced by someone they were dating or going out with to do sexual things they did not want to on one or more occasion during the past 12 months

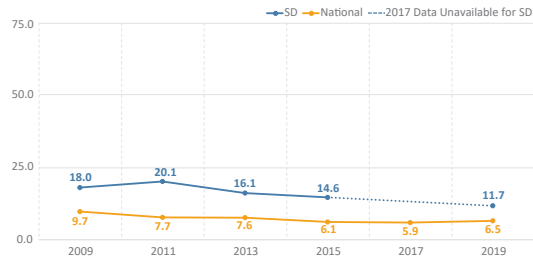

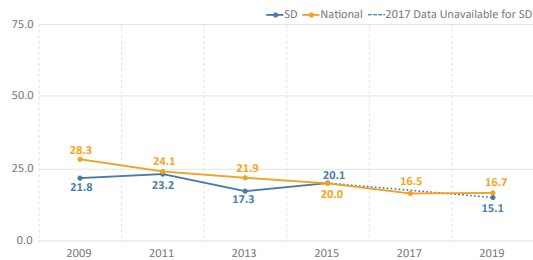

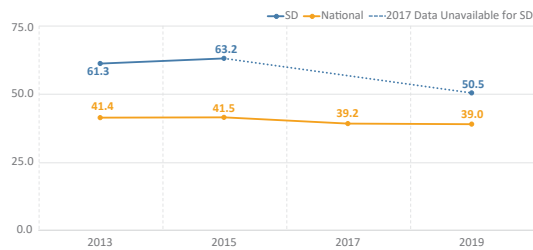
Percent of students who rarely or never wear a seat belt when riding in a car or other vehicle



Percent of students who rode one or more times in the past 30 days in a car or other vehicle driving by someone who had been drinking alcohol

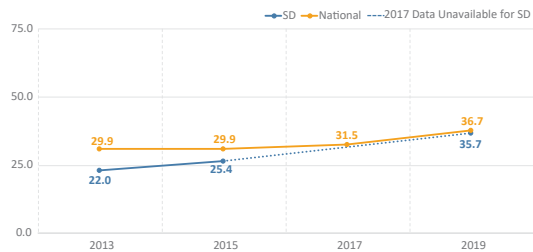


Among students who drove a car in the past 30 days, the percent who texted or emailed while driving on one or more of the days

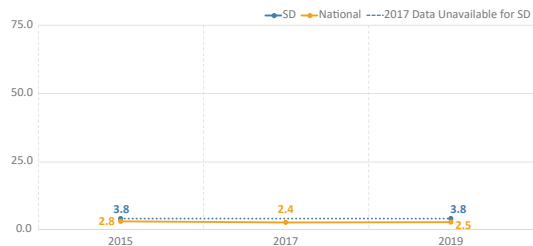


Suicide

In the past 12 months, the percent of students who felt so sad or hopeless almost every day for two or more weeks in a row that they stopped during their usual activities

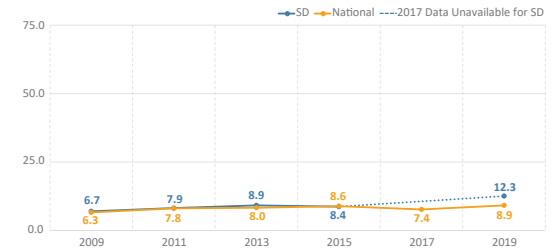


The percentage of student who made a suicide attempt in the past 12 months that resulted in an injury, poisoning, or overdose that had to be treated by a doctor or nurse



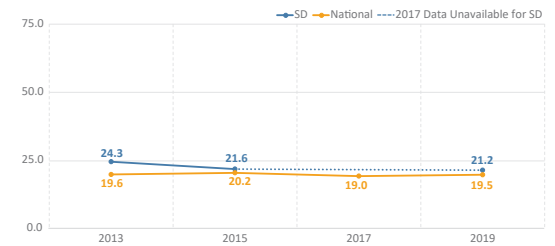

The percent of students who attempted suicide one or more times during the past 12 months

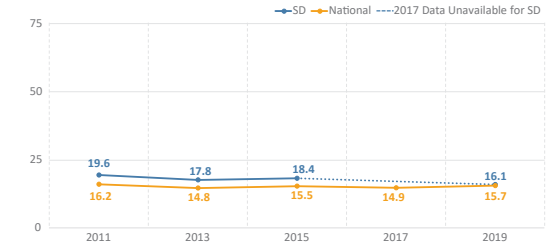

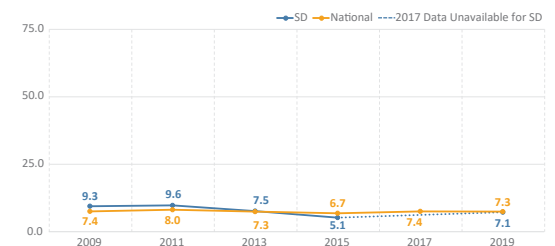
Percent of students bullied on school property in the past 12 months
